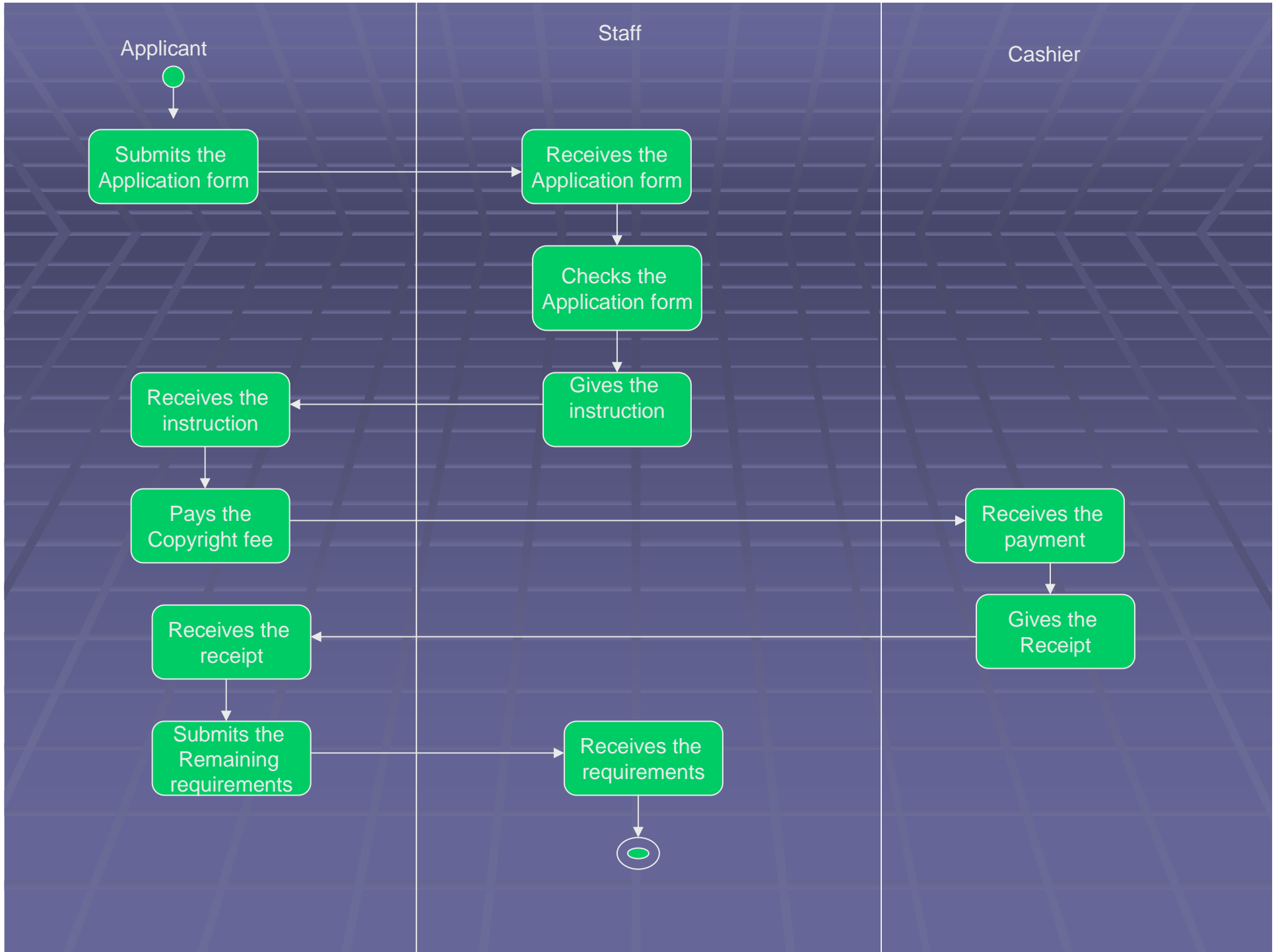

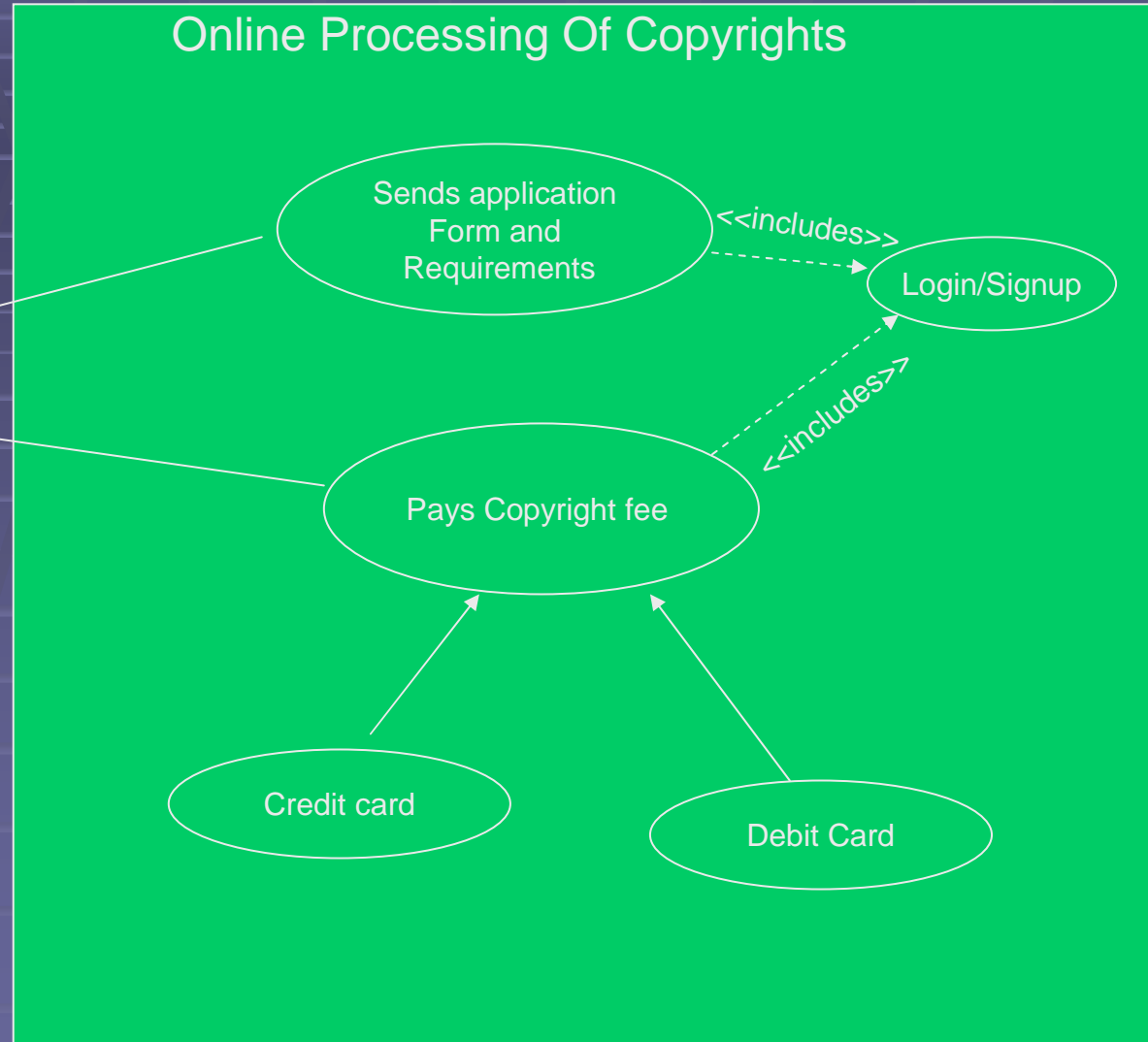

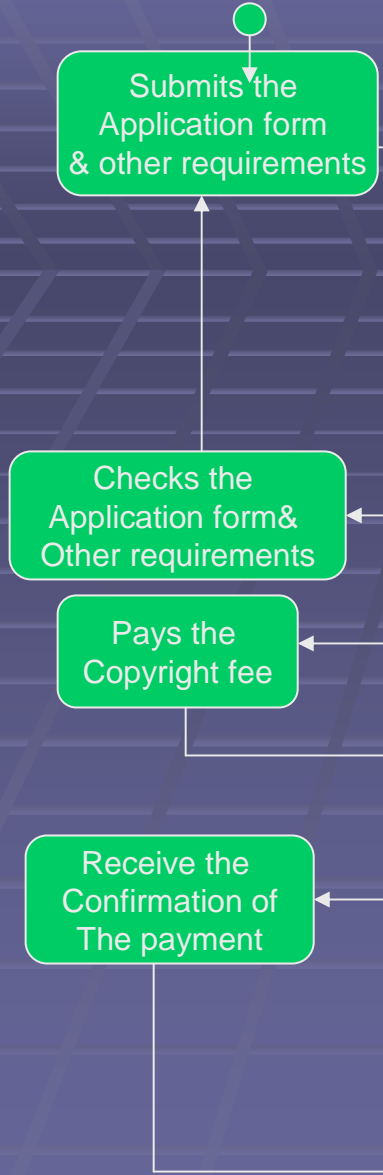


Proposed System

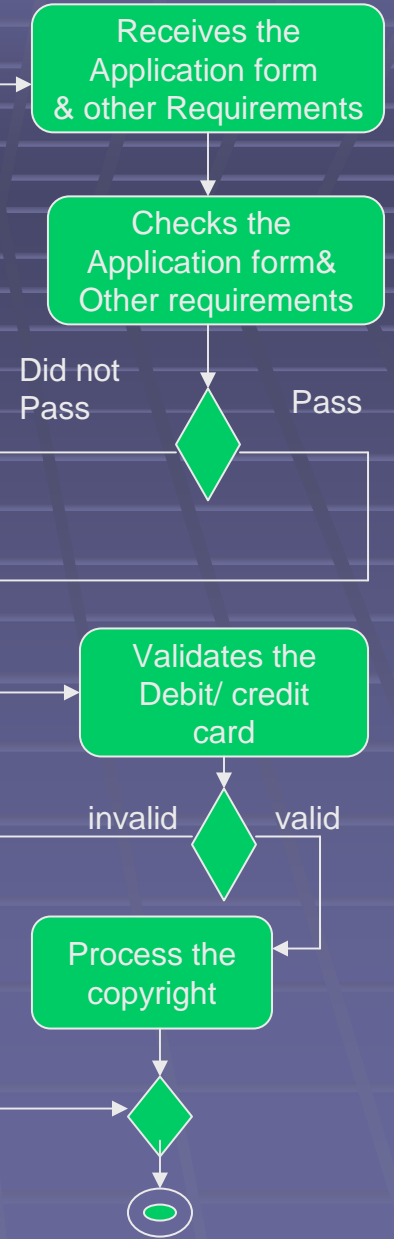
